To preregister for a vaccine appointment at the Volusia County Fairgrounds, visit myvaccine.fl.gov or call [866-201-7314](tel:866-201-7314). Once preregistered, individuals will receive a call when vaccine appointments become available. When called for an appointment, Sharecare representatives will ask for first and last name, date of birth, and email address and/or phone number; individuals will never be asked to provide their social security number. At this time the Volusia County Fairgrounds is only vaccinating individuals 65 years of age and older and health care personnel with direct patient contact.
